### GRADE 11

English 11

Principles of Mathematics 11,

Language 11 (beginner's language accepted),

A Science 11 (acceptable subjects are Biology 11, Chemistry 11, Earth Science 11, Physics 11)

**GRADE 12:** English 12 and three Grade 12 provincially examinable courses.

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: QUANTITATIVE SKILLS AND ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

*SFU degree programs require specific high school math courses for admissions. Applicants must demonstrate competence in quantitative and analytical skills by obtaining a grade 70% or above in the math course required by their programs OR by obtaining a grade between 60% to 69% in the math course required by their program, and satisfy additional quantitative requirements within their first three terms enrolled at SFU. *Students must obtain a grade of 75% or higher in an eligible English 12/English Literature 12 course OR obtain a grade of 60% to 74% in an eligible English 12/English Literature course, and satisfy additional literacy requirements within their first three terms enrolled at SFU.
