PROGRAMS REQUIRING ONE OR MORE YEARS OF UNIVERSITY EDUCATION:

Entered following first year: Acting and Film Production (BFA), Pharmaceutical Sciences

Entered following second year: Studio Art (BA & BFA), Theatre and Design, Environmental Design, Social Work, Nursing

Entered following third year or a degree: Dentistry, Education, Law, Medicine
